



“Golden Graduates of Winchester High School A Small Indiana Community’s Remarkable Achievement”

Book 2 of the Winchester Golden Graduate Project

“Golden Graduates of Winchester High School” is a 350-page hardcover book composed of a collection of 30 biographical essays, a sampling of Winchester High School graduates who have made significant contributions to the betterment of society. Among those whose stories appear are lawyers, physicians, medical researchers, engineers, teachers, writers, philanthropists, business people, and politicians, among others. They have influenced U.S. economic policy, invented a pump that saves you time at the gasoline station, presided over the U.S. Legal Services Corporation during the Reagan administration, produced research used in the Moon Landing, won the Nobel Prize in chemistry, advised the Saudi Royal Family in establishing schools in Saudi Arabia, applied mechanical engineering skills to be able to live off the grid in northern Canada, discovered and developed the first commercial natural gas reservoir ever found offshore Israel, promoted excellence in industry and endowed a major educational program in Winchester, became a Hall of Fame television journalist and best-selling author, was an honest politician who received the highest number of votes ever in Randolph County elections, is a 19-time Emmy award winner in TV sports production, and led a major pharmaceutical company in the development of the COVID-19 vaccine. While these graduates, along with those not mentioned, differ greatly in their fields of endeavor, all of them had extraordinary careers that were influenced by their education and upbringing in Winchester, Indiana. Also included in the book is a Foreword by Jane Marie Lind, Dane Starbuck’s explanation of why Winchester has hundreds of Golden Graduates, a brief history of the consolidation of Winchester Schools, an article that recognizes the 150th year of Winchester High School, and an explanation of the inclusion of five Golden Graduates who did *not* graduate from Winchester but represent the five school districts that consolidated with Winchester.
