





#### Golden Graduate Book #2



Book #2 is going to be fabulous whenever its authors get it finished! Yes, we're moving more slowly than anticipated, but the new biographical format we've established for this book simply takes more time. Be assured that when it's finished, you will be amazed at this second group of Winchester graduates! You'll love reading about the life and career of Chester Burleigh Watts, an astronomer from the Class of 1907 who became one of the most important astronomers of the 20th century. He worked at the U.S. Naval Observatory in Washington, D.C. for 50 years and photographed and mapped the surface of the moon. His life-long work was still in use by scientists in preparation for the moon landing in 1969. Our youngest graduate in the book is Wade Junco, Class of 1992. 17-time Emmy award winner, friend and confidant to John Madden, Wade is one of the most influential men to play a role in professional football today.

Another feature of Book 2 is that we are recognizing the 5 rural school districts that consolidated to form present-day Randolph Central School Corporation (Winchester Schools) by writing a "Golden Graduate" story from each of their districts. One of the five is Leon F. Hesser (1943 graduate of Lincoln High School, West White River Twp). With a PHD in agriculture from Purdue, Leon led US Department of Agriculture large scale grain development projects that provided crops for millions in 20 countries around the world. He became known as "The Man Who Fed the World." Check the website for further updates!


